

### Les Cayes Pastor's Seminar

Little did I ever dream, while living in Haiti, that the tremendous opportunity that we experienced in Les Cayes would ever happen. While I was trying to translate the Confession of Faith into simple language that our congregation in Allegre, Haiti could read and understand, I found some of our English statements were in old English that was hard to translate. I also noticed that there were only a few supporting verses for each of the points in the Confession. The initial printing was received in our church with great excitement. It was then I began to realize that there is really little of this kind of simple, Biblical doctrinal material available in the Haitian Kreyol language. LIFE Literature saw a copy of this Confession and asked permission to reprint and distribute it on a larger scale in Haiti.

Monday, February 16, 2015 our team headed to Les

Cayes. The team was made up of David and Ada Troyer (N.C.), Lamar & Miriam Nolt (N.C.), Harold Herr (Haiti) and myself. We met our contact from the area, Dan Elliot, who organized the complete three day seminar for us. On the first day, we were pleased for the opportunity to teach approximately one hundred national church leaders from Lutheran, Reformed, Evangelical, Apostolic, Pentecostal, United Methodist, Independent and Baptist Churches. It was a very mixed group of Protestants that even included one of Haiti's senators.

David and Lamar shared in teaching about the Shepherd and his family and home for three of the sessions which was well appreciated. I started with the authority of the Scriptures. This was well received. We went to the doctrine of the Trinity which was also fairly well accepted. When we got to the doctrine of the Two Kingdoms we ended up with some very active and engaging discussions during the question and answer periods.

Next we taught the seven Christian ordinances, illustrated as seven pillars of a mighty temple built on three strong foundations:

1. Jesus Christ and His teachings
2. The apostles and their teachings
3. Our personal faith and repentance.

We had a great time interacting with these leaders in class, at lunch and breaks. Not all were one hundred percent open to our teachings, but most were quite open and received the teachings with joy. What a rare opportunity to influence so many from such diversity for the Kingdom of God's sake.

Along with our many Creole items, LIFE has now added a few French materials to its selection of literature; We now have over 40 books and Bibles, plus over 40 tracts and posters!
